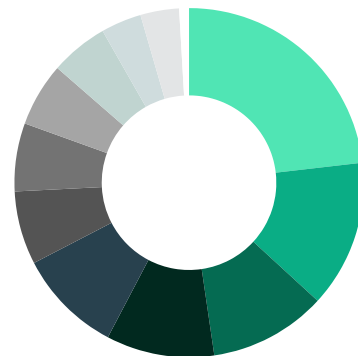

Important Risks

Investments involve risk. Principal loss is possible. **Value Investing Risk.** Securities issued by companies that may be perceived as undervalued may fail to appreciate for long periods of time and may never realize their full potential value. For example, the Fund incurs operating expenses and portfolio transaction costs not incurred by the Index. In addition, the Fund may not be fully invested in the securities of the Index at all times or may hold securities not included in the Index. **Index Calculation Risk.** The Index relies on various sources of information to assess the criteria of issuers included in the Index, including fundamental information that may be based on assumptions and estimates.

Glossary:

Bloomberg US 1000 Value Total Return Index: Bloomberg LP ("Bloomberg") is the licensor of The Bloomberg US 1000 Value Index (the "Index"). Bloomberg US 1000 Value Total Return Index provides exposure to companies with superior value factor scores based on their earnings yield, valuation, dividend yield, and growth.

Market Price: The current price at which shares are bought and sold. Market returns are based upon the last trade price.

NAV: The dollar value of a single share, based on the value of the underlying assets of the fund minus its liabilities, divided by the number of shares outstanding. Calculated at the end of each business day.
